

- **Safety and Supervision are the #1 priority at all times.** Be sure that campers are closely supervised and always stay on paved or gravel paths when traveling around camp. Do not go “off trail” through the woods. (Depending on weather, wooden decks or paths may become very slippery)
- **Quiet time at Camp is 11:00 pm and curfew is 12:00 am.**
- **Meals:**
  - Meal times are 8:00 for breakfast, 12:00 for lunch and 6:00 dinner, unless discussed with group leader. Meals will be served cafeteria style. Food will only be served at the beginning of the meal time and we cannot guarantee there will be food leftover for anyone who is late.
- **Maintenance Needs:** Please report any maintenance or housekeeping needs to your group leader.
- **Smoking policy – only in designated area (deck at Dining hall)**
- **Alcohol/drug policy – prohibited**
- **Weapons - prohibited**
- **Severe Weather plan – see attachment**
- **Vehicle Parking – limited parking in lot by Lions Lodge and Marc Roberts Lodge. All other cars should park in grass area by Tennis Courts. Please do not drive on paths or park in any other grass areas.**
- **No pets**

- Please clean up after yourselves. Dumpsters are located behind Dining Hall.
- Please help us conserve energy by not adjusting thermostats and leaving doors or windows open. Be sure to turn off lights when leaving a building or area, especially the gym, tennis courts and dining hall.
- We ask that you do not use anything on our walls or ceilings that will damage them, such as: duct tape, nails, or staples. Glitter and “silly string” are never a good idea either.
