Note: All nominees will be dues paying members of the district in which they have been nominated and have the following qualifications per PI Bylaws SECTION 7 a. A nominee for Secretary or Treasurer will have served on a Pilot Club Executive Board for two (2) years (President, President Elect, Secretary, Treasurer or Director).
