NOMINATING ALABAMA DISTRICT OFFICERS FOR 2024-2025

Governor Elect Laurie Fraser would love to have YOU on her team for 2024-2025. To do this you must meet the following PI Bylaw requirements:

- ✓ Be a dues-paying active member of a Pilot club.
- ✓ A nominee for Governor Elect, Treasurer or Secretary will have served as President of a Pilot Club.
- ✓ A nominee should have attended district conventions to a creditable degree.
- ✓ For Governor Elect: Attendance at a recent PI convention prior to the time of being elected is required. The nominee should be qualified to address clubs on the activities and plans of the district and PI.
- ✓ For Treasurer: A nominee should be proficient in financial management procedures.
- ✓ For Secretary: A nominee should be qualified to record, transcribe and distribute the minutes of various meetings related to administration of the District.

A club should submit nominees to the nominating committee 60 days prior to District Convention. The deadline for nominations is **February 12, 2024.** Mail completed qualification forms to Sherre McGinnis, 109 Tuckahoe Circle, Gadsden, AL 35904. The forms will be verified, and references checked by the nominating committee and forwarded to the District Governor and the ECR.
