CRITERIA FOR JUDGING BRAIN-RELATED AND COMMUNITY SERVICE AWARDS

- 1. An application form for each award should be submitted.
- 2. All applications should be postmarked by the announced postmark deadline. All envelopes shall be kept with the entry.
- 3. Only one entry per club per award.
- 4. If additional sheets are used for supporting the application, these should all be put together in some type of binder to allow for easy access in judging.
- 5. The Governor shall be notified of any disqualifications immediately, and the treason(s) thereof.
- 6. Each judge should have time to read and study each application separately and mark their tally sheet.
- 7. A tally sheet with a point system will be provided for each judge.
- 8. After each judge completes a tally sheet for each entry, the chair will count the results. The entry with the most points will be declared the winner.
- 9. Winners will be announced at the Awards Luncheon at District Convention.
- 10. The Governor should be notified of the winners as per instruction.
- 11. All entries and tally sheets should be turned over to the DAC at District Convention.
